Why choosing POAST Ultra makes sense

POAST ULTRA herbicide combines consistent, economical control of annual and perennial grasses in blueberries with excellent crop safety and a wide application window.

POAST ULTRA:

- Proven control of annual and perennial grasses.
- Excellent crop safety.
- Registered for use on more than 60 horticultural and field crops.

How POAST ULTRA Works

- Delay treatment of grasses under extreme conditions (frost, drought, very high temperatures) until they resume active growth.
- Include at least 1% MERGE[®] surfactant in the final sprayer solution (1 liter product for each 100 liters of dilute spray).

How to use POAST ULTRA

Annual Grasses:

- Apply POAST ULTRA at 320-470 mL/ha (130-190 mL/ac)
 - Increase rate to control tillering grasses

Perennial Grasses:

- Apply POAST ULTRA at 1.1 L/ha (440 mL/ac)
- Tank-mix POAST ULTRA with MERGE[®] surfactant at a rate of at least 1% (1 L of MERGE for every 100 L of spray solution)
- POAST ULTRA performs best at moderate water volumes (15 gal/acre)

Delay treatment of grasses growing under dry conditions until they resume active growth.

Wild Oats and Volunteer Cereals:*** Wild oats, volunteer barley, volunteer wheat.	1 - 4	0.32
Annual Grasses: Barnyard grass, crabgrass (large), fall panicum, foxtail (green/yellow; wild millet), persian darnel, proso millet, volunteer corn, witchgrass.	1 - 6	0.47
Wild Oats and Volunteer Cereals: Wild oats, volunteer barley, volunteer wheat.	1 - 6	0.47
Quackgrass Suppression: (Western Canada only)	2 - 5	0.47
Quackgrass Control plus annual grasses listed above	1 - 3	1.1
Foxtail Barley Suppression plus annual grasses listed above	1 - 4	1.1

* For band application, adjust rate per hectare in relation to the band width (annual grasses only).

Merge Adjuvant should be added at a rate of at least 1% of the water volume used.

** EASTERN CANADA ONLY. Assist® Oil Concentrate can be substituted for Merge Adjuvant (at same rates) for the control of annual grasses listed for the low Poast Ultra liquid emulsifiable herbicide rate.

*** In canola, flax (low linolenic acid varieties) and peas only.
